FREDERICTON (July 25, 2012) – October 1, 2012 is the application deadline for the next grant programs assessed by a jury, the **artsnb** Creation and Documentation programs.

The **Creation Grant Program** is designed to provide assistance to individual emerging, mid-career and senior professional New Brunswick artists for the research, development and execution of original projects in the arts. Creation Grants are intended to allow artists to devote some or most of their time to research and creative production.

The **Documentation Grant Program** is designed to provide assistance to New Brunswick arts professionals and professional artists for the research, development, and execution of original documentation and contextualization (written, film, video, multimedia) of arts activities, arts products or art history. Documentation grants are intended to foster theoretical and critical discourse in the arts. Preference will be given to proposals concerning New Brunswick art or artists.

These competitions are open to those working in architecture, craft, literary arts, media arts, performing arts (dance, music, storytelling and theatre), and visual arts. Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria for the above programs. All admissible applications will be evaluated by a jury by discipline selected from a list of jurors approved by **artsnb**. The results of the competitions will be announced approximately three months following the closing date.
