EQUINOX PROGRAM FOR INDIGENOUS ARTISTS



Find out everything you need to know to get started!

The **Equinox Program** supports Indigenous artists, curators, collectives and groups to engage in artistic creation, career development and capacity building.

There are three types of Equinox grants:

- **Research and Development**
Funds applicants to develop their artistic practice by attending workshops, mentorships and residencies.
- **Creation of New Work**
Funds applicants to create new artwork with culturally specific dialogues.
- **Connections**
Funds applicants to organize conferences, workshops, gatherings or exchanges that will strengthen the Indigenous arts community.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications must be received by **September 15th**.

- The maximum grant amount is \$5,000.
- Projects must begin after the deadline.
- Applicants may apply to one category per year.

ELIGIBILITY

Indigenous artists, curators, collectives and groups may apply.

Applicants must be New Brunswick citizens or permanent residents.

Full-time students, Indigenous Bands or groups directly linked to a Band are not eligible.

HOW TO APPLY

Send a one-minute oral video describing your project idea or a 350 word written project description to:

The Indigenous Program Coordinator can assist applicants with preparing the remainder of their application, including a budget to show how they will use the grant, a résumé of their artistic background and experience, and samples of their previous artistic work.

IMPORTANT: Please send your project idea at least 2 weeks before the program deadline to give the Indigenous Program Coordinator adequate time to assist with the application process.
