

Grants awarded for February 1, 2020 Competition – Artist in Residence and Creative Residencies (Québec) Programs

March 19th, 2020, Fredericton – The New Brunswick Arts Board (**artsnb**) has released the results of the February 1st, 2020 competitions for the Artist in Residence and Creative Residencies (Québec) Programs. Grants totaling **\$60,000** were awarded by juries of professional artists under these two funding programs. These funds were allocated as follows:

Artist in Residence
