Jean-Pierre Caissie has been a cultural worker and artist in Moncton, Ottawa, and Montreal. He has worked in theatre and film festivals, has managed a music band, has been a photographer, editor, DJ, director of a filmmakers' association, and artistic coordinator of an artist-run center. Over the years, he has been involved on the boards of arts organizations and has served on the editorial boards of literary journals. At the time of his appointment as Executive Director of artsnb, Jean-Pierre was Assistant Director of the Association acadienne des artistes professionnel.le.s du Nouveau-Brunswick (AAAPNB).
