César Suárez joins the artsnb Board of Directors

Fredericton, November 29, 2022 – The New Brunswick Arts Board (**artsnb**) is proud to announce that **César Suárez** has been appointed to its Board of Directors for a three-year mandate.

Dr. César Suárez is a Venezuelan-Canadian classical musician with more than thirty-five years of successful performing, teaching experience and orchestra conducting in different countries.

In Venezuela, César was the Orchestra Conductor, viola and violin teacher of Sistema Monagas and the Monagas State Symphony Orchestra Conductor in the city of Maturín from 2009 to 2017. He was a member of the Simón Bolívar Symphony Orchestra and a Viola Faculty at the music conservatory Simón Bolívar in Caracas from 1988 to 1996. Since 2017, César has resided in Canada where he has worked as the orchestra

conductor of Sistema New Brunswick, Saint John, and the Saint John Youth Orchestra. He has a doctoral degree at Michigan State University, a master's degree in Music Performance at Carnegie Mellon University, an artist diploma in viola performance at Duquesne University in the USA and a performance degree in viola at the music conservatory Simon Bolivar of El Sistema in Caracas.

Membership of the Board reflect the diversity found in the province's arts community and where possible includes representation from differing art disciplines, generations, and cultural mosaics including the two official linguistic communities, and First Nations, as well as gender and geographic diversity.
