Grants awarded for August 1, 2024 Deadline – Arts Infrastructure Grant for New and Emerging Artists

Fredericton, October 8, 2024 – The New Brunswick Arts Board (**artsnb**) has released the results of the August 1, 2024 deadline for the Arts Infrastructure Grant for New and Emerging Artists. Twenty-three (23) Arts Infrastructure grants were awarded, totaling **\$ 59,389.94**.

The Arts Infrastructure Grant for New and Emerging Artists is a project-based program designed to provide a one-time capital acquisition to newly-arrived immigrants and emerging New Brunswick artists to acquire equipment that will enable them to complete a project and strengthen their long-term artistic development. 15 out of 23 recipients (65.2 %) had never previously received a grant from artsnb.

The number of applications evaluated per discipline for this program deadline are as follows: 0 in architecture, 10 in craft, 0 in dance, 1 in literary arts, 2 in media arts, 5 in multidisciplinary arts, 6 in music, 1 in theatre, and 14 in visual arts.

The New Brunswick Arts Board is an arm's length arts funding agency with a legislated mandate to facilitate and promote the creation of art as well as administering funding programs for professional artists in the province. Funding for these programs is provided through the province's Arts Development Trust Fund and by the Department of Tourism, Heritage and Culture. The department also provides dedicated funding to the Artist in Residence program, as a response to the recommendations from the report of the Premier's Task Force on the Status of the Artist.
