# 15 out of 20 recipients (75.0 %) had never previously received a grant from artsnb.

The number of applications evaluated per discipline for this program deadline are as follows: 2 in architecture, 2 in craft, 5 in dance, 0 in literary arts, 1 in media arts, 2 in multidisciplinary arts, 4 in music, 1 in theatre, and 16 in visual arts.

The department has also announced additional funding to the Artist in Residence program, as a response to the recommendations from the report of Premier's Task Force on the Status of the Artist.
