Grants awarded for April 1, 2025 Deadlines – Creation and Documentation programs

Fredericton, June 20, 2025 – The New Brunswick Arts Board (**artsnb**) has released the results of the April 1, 2025 deadlines for the Creation and Documentation programs. Grants totaling **\$ 1,054,999.80** were awarded by juries composed of professional artists in these two (2) funding programs.

Creation Program

Sixty-three (63) grants were awarded for the Creation program totaling \$ 1,000,075.80.

The Creation Grant program is designed to provide assistance to professional New Brunswick artists for the research, development and execution of original projects in the arts. Creation Grants are intended to allow artists to devote some or most of their time to research and creative production. With the input of the community through a series of consultations, artsnb simplified the categories in the Creation program which are now Artist and Artist – emerging career. This deadline is the first with these new and improved categories.

Category: Artist

Of 143 applications evaluated in the Artist category, 53 grants were awarded. 12 of these grant recipients had never previously received a grant from artsnb. The following artists receive grants in this program:

17 out of 63 recipients (27.0 %) had never previously received a grant from artsnb.

The number of applications evaluated per discipline for this program deadline are as follows: 2 in architecture, 12 in craft, 4 in dance, 23 in literary arts, 22 in media arts, 23 in multidisciplinary arts, 33 in music, 11 in theatre, and 51 in visual arts.

Of note, \$2,838,932.24 is the highest total amount requested for a Creation program deadline in artsnb's history.

Documentation program

Six (6) grants were awarded for the <u>Documentation</u> program, totaling \$54,924.

The Documentation Grant Program is designed to provide assistance to New Brunswick arts professionals and professional artists for the research, development, and execution of original documentation and contextualization (written, film, video, multimedia) of arts activities, arts products or art history. Documentation grants are intended to foster theoretical and critical discourse in the arts.

Funding for these programs is provided through the province's Arts Development Trust Fund and by the Department of Tourism, Heritage and Culture. The department also provides additional funding to the Artist in Residence program, as a response to the recommendations from the report of Premier's Task Force on the Status of the Artist.
