## Grants awarded for August 1, 2025 Deadline – Arts Infrastructure program

*Fredericton, October 7, 2025* – The New Brunswick Arts Board (**artsnb**) has released the results of the August 1, 2025 deadline for the Arts Infrastructure program. **Twenty-one (21)** grants were awarded by a jury composed of professional artists, totaling **\$60,095.98**.

The **Arts Infrastructure** program is open to early-career artists and artists who are newly arrived to Canada. This grant is designed to allow these artists to acquire tools and equipment or to improve their facilities, with the goal to strengthen their long-term capacity to create. The New Brunswick Arts Board is an arm's length arts funding agency with a legislated mandate to facilitate and promote the creation of art as well as administering funding programs for professional artists in the province. Funding for these programs is provided through the province's Arts Development Trust Fund and by the Department of Tourism, Heritage and Culture. The department also provides additional funding to the Artist in Residence program, as a response to the recommendations from the report of Premier's Task Force on the Status of the Artist.
